DIRECTIONS TO THE HOTEL

Upon arriving at Schiphol airport, please take any train to Amsterdam Centraal Station. There is a station in the airport and trains to Amsterdam leave about every 10-15 minutes. From Central Station you can either take a taxi to the hotel (which should cost no more than 20 Euro), or take the Metro. The taxi rank is located outside the main entrance of the station, to the right of the main concourse when standing with your back to the station entrance. The Metro station is in front of the railway station; follow the signs. You can take any Metro; they leave every few minutes and all go in the right direction. Get off after a five-minute ride at the third stop, Weesperplein. Weesperplein station has several exits. Take the one that says Stadstimmerplein. When you come out, walk straight ahead and take the second street on the left. At the end of the street you turn right. After 100 meters, the Bridge Hotel will be on your right hand side.

DIRECTIONS TO SCIENCE PARK

The Institute is located at Science Park 904

The easiest way of getting to the Institute from the hotel, is to take a metro from Weesperplein metro station, going in the direction of Westwijk, Gaasperplas or Gein. After 2 stops get out at Amstelstation. Exit the station and take bus 40 or 240 to Science Park Amsterdam. The bus stop

where you should exit the bus is called Science Park. For a timetable of busses 40 and 240 please use the following website: www.9292.nl.

You can recognize the faculty building by the two domes on top (one has the number 904 on it). The building is also (currently) the largest building in the Science Park. Walk under the building between the pillars into the central area to find the main entrance. Please register your arrival at the desk in the main hall.
